MATCH SECRETARY'S REPORT FOR COMMITTEE MEETING AT BURFORD GOLF CLUB ON 27th APRIL, 2017

(1) 2017 CLUB CAPTAINS

Nine of our 2017 golf club Captains have now enlisted in the OGC but one has sadly declined. We are still looking for five of the home Captains, whose clubs have 2017 OGC events to join, although three of these have received and apparently accepted our invitations to play with us in their home events.

Those yet to join are 2017 Captains of;

Bicester, Cotswolds, Carswell, Drayton Park, Henley, North Oxford, The Springs, Studley Wood and Witney Lakes golf clubs.

(2) 2017 FIXTURES

As I mentioned at our last meeting, the initial response to our "availability" circulation was once again very slow but it has picked up since then and I now have received a total of 120 replies, which compares well with the same point last year.

Also since our last meeting, I have circulated the teams for 17 of our 20 matches, the remaining three being those to be played in Cornwall next month. The available match places were vastly over-subscribed, so in the event you should receive complaints from members about being allocated fewer matches than they imagined they should, this is the reason you can provide please.

There were six responses received after the team selections were circulated but I will endeavour to find matches for these Captains as and when selected members fall by the wayside.

The first of our team letters was circulated last week and, as usual, there are still 11 of the 17 Captains named yet to respond.

Nothing much has changed since our last meeting with the numbers remaining static at 20 Captains who will be travelling with us.
